10 Survival Tools That Should Be In Your Survival Pack

Let's be honest, survival is not something you want to gamble your life on. Meeting your basic needs during a disaster is key to survival, and having the right set of tools to fall back on is paramount in your preparedness endeavors.

The ten tools listed below are some of the most important survival tools that should be in your 72-hour bags or survival bags. Practice using these tools regularly so that you know their capability and their strength.

1. **Water Treatment:** We simply cannot live without water. The more energy you consume, the more water your body will need. Having a means to purify water in a survival situation will help keep you hydrated, your brain functioning properly and your focus on survival. In addition, if you sustain an injury, water can be poured over the wound for cleaning.
2. **Compass and Map:** Knowing which direction you are headed and where you need to be is essential. Keep maps of your surrounding area at home (in case you have to evacuate by foot), in your car and in your survival bags.
3. **Fire Starter: flint bars, matches or lighter:** Having a way to produce fire can help you cook food and keep warm and prevent hypothermia.
4. **First Aid Kit:** You do not want to be caught in a survival situation without a first aid kit. This kit assists in injury treatment and helps prevent infections from perpetuating.
5. **Mirror:** Used for signaling, checking face for wounds, looking at your back for wounds/ticks, and can be used to start fire.
6. **Rope:** This can be used for making snares or assisting in making other traps lashing branches together to build a shelter, assisting in first aid (splints, tourniquets, slings), or to make survival tools such as spears.
7. **Survival Blanket or Bivvy:** A bivvy or survival blanket can be

used as an emergency shelter, sleeping bag or can be an extra layer added to your existing sleeping bag if you are expecting a cold night.

8. **Multi-tool:** Used for notching or more complex wood working skills, opening cans, altering equipment, medical uses, if snare wire is around wire cutters can cut it.
9. **Lighting:** Lanterns, light sticks, flashlights, and head lamps can help you find your way if in the dark. LEDs, solar and hand crank will get you the most for your money.
10. **Survival Knife:** Survival knives should be made of good quality steel. Invest in one you can rely on. Make sure it is well made, is strong enough for rough field use, and is the best you can afford.

Bottom line is your preparedness tools are your life line and without them, you could be ill-equipped in a survival situation.

How to Guard Against Home Invasions

The act of committing a home invasion is escalating. Times are tough and money is short. This is the perfect storm for an increase in home invasion. Businesses understand this and have made thefts more difficult. The homeowner has not beefed up his security in the same way, which makes homeowners the easier target.

Thieves know most home owners do not have alarm systems or video cameras. Home invasions can be accomplished without anyone taking notice or realizing something is wrong. Once invaders are in your home if you are there, you may be forced to reveal where your valuables are kept and even pressured into divulging passwords for bank accounts and more.

Invaders are becoming more brazen. They often break in during the daylight hours, even when someone is home. Most often thieves will knock on the door and when there is no answer they will slip around to the back and break in. More and more invaders do not work alone, and they will push their way into your home as you answer your door and hold you captive. What can you do?

Be aware. Some years ago, we lived where our back fence bordered the parking lot of our ward's chapel. We had a convenient gate in that fence that made access to Sunday meetings easy. Unfortunately, it also made access easy to our home.

After a short three-day trip, we returned home and parked the car in the garage. After retiring, the lights were out, and the family was in bed for the night. Then, the sound of a car idling could be heard from the back of our home.

My husband looked out the window and a sedan was backed up to our back gate. Someone got out of the car and opened the trunk as if ready to load up. Of course, we didn't turn on the interior lights, but we turned on our outside lights, and the would-be burglar made a quick getaway. It was a wake up call, in a town where we thought crime couldn't touch us.

Don't answer the door, or at least don't open it. It is just fine for you to speak with someone at the door through a closed door. Just ask, who is it? This will signal them that you are home but will not expose you to risk. If you should have to open the door, be sure others are aware you are answering and they are ready to call 911 quickly.

Get out! If you hear someone in your home, get out without being noticed and call 911 from a neighbor's home or on your cell phone when you are far enough away that you can't be heard. Given this grim news, how can we prepare our homes to be more secure — whether we are at home, or away?

Scream. If you should surprise an invader, scream and run. Do not confront anyone. Go to a neighbor's home or into a safe room.

There are also many things you should do now to make a break in more difficult and survival more possible.

Create a plan. Teach your children what to do and where to go if they hear someone or if they suspect someone is in your home. Practice the plan. Plans are worth nothing if they are not practiced. Teach your children to arm and/or use your alarm in case of an invasion. Practice always locking doors and windows, even when home.

Create a safe room. Select an interior room or large closet with no windows or skylights. A safe room should have only one entrance. Replace doors and door frames with solid core or steel doors and jambs. If possible doors should open out to make it harder to kick in. Installation or refitting should be with three-inch

screws. Doors should have a good lock that can be locked from the inside. If you have small children you may want to make this a keyed lock.

Stock your room with emergency supplies such as food, water, a flashlight or glow sticks, a first-aid kit, cell phone and a way to defend yourself. Be sure you have good ventilation. If you are home when an intruder breaks in, go into your safe room, call 911, and be quiet. Avoid contact if at all possible.

Identify your security weaknesses. Begin by walking around your home and making note of areas where access to a window or door may go unnoticed by neighbors. Look in the windows. Are there valuables that are easily seen and tempting to a thief? Look for easy access points such as sliding doors. Do you have ladders stored outside, making it easy for a second-story man?

Look at your home through a burglar's eyes, as if you wanted to break in. Find the weaknesses, and fix them as well as you can.

Purchase timers. Place timers in several locations in your home and do it now. Have them turn on lights as well as a radio or TV. Purchase timers that can be set to go on and off more than once during a 24-hour period.

For example, set some to turn on at dusk and off when people normally go to bed. Set another to go on at 9pm and off at 10pm and then come on at 6:05am. Set a radio in the same room to come on at 9pm and go off at 10pm and come back on at 6am. Have another light go on at 6:30 somewhere else in your home, giving the illusion that someone has

gotten up and is moving around the house. Finally, if you have a second floor, make sure to have a light up there also. Now leave them alone. If you go out and get home after dark there will be lights on to welcome you and anyone watching your home will never really be sure if you are home or not, because the pattern appears a bit random, and continues every day.

Clean out the garage. I am so sorry about this one. We have this challenge too. You may need to purchase some storage bins and build a shelf or two. The goal is to be able to park your cars in the garage. When you are away it won't seem obvious that you are gone if your driveway is empty, as usual.

You hate to believe it, but a lot of local crime can come from people in your own neighborhood, or their kids, or their friends. Every time our property has been vandalized, it has been by someone living in our neighborhood. If getting the car in the garage is impossible arrange with a neighbor to park their car in your driveway on occasion when you are away.

Make copies of all your important papers and send them to your emergency out-of-state contact. Thieves sometimes cover their tracks by setting fire to what they can't carry. Home fires can happen from accidental causes while we are away, too.

Get valuables out of the house. Arrange to leave valuables with a family member while you are gone for a few days. Purchase a small lock box and give it to them for safekeeping. Invest in outdoor lighting.

Any amount of light around your home will make your home less desirable to a thief.

These can even be solar floodlights that won't add any cost to your utilities.

Get window coverings and use them. Don't give a would-be thief a preview of what you have in your home. When it gets dark and the inside lights come on, close all window coverings. For the same reason, if you work during the day, keep window coverings closed. Never leave jewelry, money or other valuables where they can be seen. If someone is going to steal from you make them work to find valuables.

Check the locks on all entry doors. Purchase locks that have locking bolts and tongues. Test this by holding the door open and turning the latch. Then press the tongue into the door with your finger. Better locks will have a secondary tongue that doesn't move. The best locks will have entire tongues that don't move.

Although we like to have the best on our front doors, the back doors are the ones most likely to be used by an intruder. Multiple locks on a door are even better. If you can't afford to purchase new locks, add a less expensive floor lock as a back up.

Check the screws in strike plates. Short screws make it easy to pry the plate off and the door open.

Floor locks. If you have a door with a window in it, add a floor lock or second lock that a thief can't reach after breaking out the window.

Deadbolts. If you can afford it, a double-keyed deadbolt is the best solution for a door with a glass pane (so a thief can't unlock it by reaching through the broken window and turning the latch — he would have to have a key). One last thing — check that the hinges of doors are on the inside, not outside of the door, and if not, get pins for those exposed hinges that cannot be simply removed.

Strengthen garage security. Garages are an easy entrance to your home. Too many people leave their garage doors open during the day when they are home and even if they are running a short errand. Once intruders have entered your garage it is easy to close the door, giving them the privacy and time they need to break down the inside door to the house.

Solid core doors in a garage are a must. Builders sometimes put cheaper doors in the garage. Check to make sure yours are not hollow-core. If they are, replacing them is a good idea.

Sliders. An estimated one-fourth of all sliding glass doors and windows are installed backwards (so the sliding part is on the outside track). This gives a criminal easy access. They simply lift out the panel and enter. Purchase a good lock for your door if you have this situation. If the door is installed correctly, purchase a secondary lock or place a dowel in the track. The dowel should be within a ¼ - inch of the track's length so the door can't be opened wide enough to fit fingers in to lift the door off the track. Some experts will tell you that dowels only work against the less persistent thieves.

Window locks. Put window stops on all first floor and basement window frames. The best ones are those that go through

the movable frame and lock it into place. A simple alternative is to drill a hole through both frames when the window is closed and place a nail in the hole. You may also want to add a second stop by opening the window slightly, not wide enough for someone to reach through, and drill a second whole. This will enable you to have the window open slightly at night and still provide some safety.

Install motion detectors in areas that are blind spots. Many homes have motion detectors on lights in front of the garage, but thieves sneak around the sides and back of the house. Place motion detectors in those locations, high enough on the wall so intruders can't easily disable them. If you see the light come on, you know you need to be on your guard.

Lock your gates. A latch on a gate just isn't good enough. An intruder can easily reach over and open the latch. Get a padlock that actually locks and requires a key or combination to open. On days when the kids are in and out of the yard, leave it off, but replace it at night and always when you leave for a day or two.

Never put your name or address on your keys. This should be a no-brainer. If your car is hot wired and stolen and your garage door opener is in the car, change the code on your garage door opener immediately, or disconnect the opener until it is changed. If your other keys were in the car, change all the locks immediately. Remember, the thief has your registration and insurance info, and knows where you live.

Lock your home when you leave. Every time.

Take the garage door opener. If you will be gone and must leave a car outside, never leave the garage door opener in the car.

Utilize neighborhood watch. Now may be the time to get involved in your neighborhood watch group. Don't have one? Then, now is the time to call the police department, ask for their suggestions, and invite the neighbors over. Neighborhood watch groups do work. They have prevented many burglaries and caught many who would have caused harm if they had not been stopped.

We have discussed securing your home as it relates to intruders while you are away. All of this advice will help prevent attacks while you are at home, as well. Our goal is to keep those who would harm us outside.

Crime will always be part of society, and may rise and fall for various reasons. We can make this as difficult as possible so criminals consider our home "not worth the trouble" and move on. Ignoring the danger, and doing nothing to prepare against it, would be silly and naïve.

THE FAT LADY'S SINGING

If Barack Obama is re-elected in 2012, this country is going to die. But for those of you who are thinking, “*Ah, but if Rick Perry is elected...*,” think again. This country is going to die anyway.

And like the old idiom that refers to the blissful state of ignorance, most folks don't want to know any more than they absolutely have to know. That way, they don't have to make decisions based on new knowledge.

Knowing their child's government school was designed as a mind-controlling device developed and maintained by the world's most powerful, *unelected* elitists might force parents to sacrifice that new car (and car

payment) so they can afford to homeschool their child. Knowing that both Democrat and Republican presidential contestants are puppets answering to that same group of powerful, unelected elitists might force a voter to vote for a third party candidate.

Government agency reports that deny the threat of Comet Elenin may well be factual, even in the face of additional evidence of an asteroid that’s supposed to be in the earth’s vicinity around the same time as Elenin (hinting the possibility of the two crossing paths and bumping into each other as depicted in **Prole Nation**, Chapter 7).

The Home Medical Kit Revisited, by Dr. Bob

Medical supplies are an essential part of survival and planning can really save you some headaches. **You cannot have too much gauze nor too many Band-Aids.** Seriously, if you have the room then keep buying them. Sterile gauze is worth having a small amount of, and non-sterile a much larger amount of. Band-Aids of all shapes are recommended, I really like the Nextcare tattoo type because they stick so well and help with blister protection as well as all sorts of small cuts. I am not really

a big Band-Aid person as I like blood and scars, but to each his own. If you feel the need to stop bleeding, nothing beats good old fashioned pressure. There is an old saying in medicine: "all bleeding stops eventually". I guess it is supposed to be partly humorous but also is meant to calm those that tend to freak out dramatically at the site of blood. Pressure on wound for a good two minutes stops the majority of bleeding wounds from knives, sharp edges, and puncturing. Holding pressure directly is the best way to approach bleeding, then after it slows or stops, then wrapping it with a nice tight bandage with gauze between will stop 95% of non-horrific injuries.

Ace wrap is great to have for a large variety of reasons, including holding together splints, wrapping larger injuries, and making a sling. It can be rewashed and used over and over until its springiness is lost. Getting a variety of sizes from 1 inch to 6 inch is the best idea, with more of the middle sizes like 2 and 3 inch. Chemical ice packs are really a good idea if there is no grid and therefore no ice. How many is a guess, most of the time if you had access to cool or cold water from creeks or springs that would eliminate most of your need for an ice pack. If you won't have access to these cooling sources, then you need to make room for more chemical ice packs than someone with a nice cold creek or spring on their property. Splints are as simple as 2 sticks wrapped with duct tape, to fancy and expensive blowup units. My favorites are the simple moldable foam splints available at any medical supply store.

To close small wounds, super glue gel or steri-strips are good for largely non-

mobile skin like the forehead or mid arm, leg, etc. If it doesn't bend much, it's non-mobile skin. For mobile skin, sutures might help, but if you don't or can't get them, then gauze and pressure is your best bet. Super glue gel is easier to control than the watery stuff and doesn't stick you to the person you are trying to help as much. If the wound bleeds then the gel will just run all over and do absolutely no good. If the bleeding from a wound just keeps oozing slowly, you have to use sutures or steri-strips to stop it and close up the wound. Even steri-strips are very tricky with bleeding as they won't stick to blood. You have a solid 8 hours to repair any injury, so the key to wound closure is **SLOW DOWN and relax** unless you see pumping blood shooting out of you or your pal. Sometimes, wrapping a wound and coming back to it an hour later makes all the difference in the world.

Besides having the supplies to repair and care for these flesh wounds, **you need to have a person available with a stomach for the job.** Someone in your small tribal society will be the medical person, so make sure they know how to use the supplies and that they are available. The "Mary Gray" of your group (see Jim's novel "Patriots") needs to train another secondary person to be an assistant or a primary medical person if the 1st choice is missing or gone. There is nothing worse than everyone freaking out because of blood and the person with the stuff and stomach being a long way away. Don't wrap any bandages or gauze over super glue wounds for a couple hours, of course. Sutures are nice, but you need the little pliers or needle driver to use them, don't forget that. Same with a curved needle

and thread, it has to either be big enough for your hotdog fingers or get a pliers or driver. The little pliers needed for this is different than the mighty pliers listed in non-medical supplies for pulling teeth, they will not be interchangeable.

So, to sum up, get a good-sized bag for all these supplies as you may need to move it to a person rather than the person to your supplies. Pack it in order of importance, when you run out of room keep the remaining supplies on the shelves in your prepper area with the food and ammo in a cool, dry place.

Gauze, Band-Aids, Ace wrap, chemical ice packs, splints, tape, steri-strips, super glue gel, sutures or curved needles, pliers or needle driver all go into the bag. The bag necessary for these items is really not that big and will not be that heavy. Keep two ice packs in the bag and lots of backups on the shelves. Keep one splint in the bag, a variety of Band-Aids, a variety of gauze and ace wraps, and a "set" of supplies for wound repair with backups for all these items on your shelves. There are certainly **many** more items that others recommend and that may be fine for some folks, this is a basic non-medical layperson recommendation. With a skilled, proficient medical person in your group your needs may be much more sophisticated, expensive, and extensive. Most people are not going to be performing surgery and pulling off blood-typing and transfusions. For those of you out there that will comfort and pray over the GSW victim, these recommendations will work. Questions and comments are always welcome. Stay strong.

YOU SERVE THE GOD YOU SEE

Stop right there. Don't read any farther than this paragraph. Close your eyes and imagine a picture of Jesus. Do it now. I'll wait.

What did you see? What image did the thought of Jesus conjure up in your mind?

This isn't a game...or a mind exercise...it is critically important. It speaks volumes about the way you live your life.

You serve the God you see.

I'm not talking about His physical attributes. At the risk of blasphemy...the size of His nose...or lips...or color of His hair...No one has ever seen the face of God and lived to tell about it. No one would be able to identify Him in a police line-up.

Jehovah...I AM...no one has ever looked Him in the eyes and lived.

Jesus is a bit of a different story. He took on the physical attributes of a human being and walked the earth. Many saw Him...walked with Him...as the incarnation of Jehovah's Spirit in fleshly man.

But that would be a description of the "person" of God. The "person" Jesus is

described in only a few places in the Bible. The closest thing we get to a description is in Isaiah 53:2b, "*He hath no form nor comeliness and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him.*"

Most of what we think Jesus looked like comes from Hollywood, paintings, or (my favorite) Bible stories from children's books. Most of the images we have of Jesus today are probably not accurate. Jesus was a Galilean, so He likely had dark skin, dark eyes, and dark hair. This is a far cry from the blond-haired, blue-eyed, fair-skinned, effeminate Jesus in many modern pictures.

But it is not the "person" (physical attributes) of Jesus that matters. If it was important, Matthew, Peter and John, who spent three years with Him, would certainly be able to give us an accurate description, as would His own brothers, James and Jude. Yet, these New Testament writers offer no details about His physical attributes.

Let me switch gears on you for a second. Take any giant from history and ask yourself the same question. Martin Luther, Galileo, the Apostle Paul, Braveheart, Jack the Ripper; are they remembered for what they looked like...or what they did?

No, my friends, the physical attributes of Jesus are irrelevant. We don't remember Him for what He looked like. We remember Him for what He did. He spoke truth to power.

It is HIS NATURE that matters. "*God is a Spirit: and they that worship Him must*

worship Him in Spirit and in Truth.”
You serve the God you see.

What God do you see? What is His nature...His attributes, if you will...His character?

It matters; you know...how you see God. Because you will serve the God you see.

“Do you think of God as an errand boy, a cosmic, doddering dotting old Grandpa, a gentleman who wouldn’t hurt a flea. Does your God dismiss sin? Is your God at the mercy of Man or Nature? Is your God too small? Is he “Itsy-bitsy, teensy-weensy?”

Or do you worship the God of the Bible? Is your God the God of Joseph, Who turns the evil intent of wicked men to His own use? (Genesis 50:20) Do you worship the God of Job, Whose greatness caused that patriarch to abhor himself and be silent? (Job 42:1-6) Do you fall down in worship of the Holy, Holy, Holy, God of Isaiah? (Isaiah 6:1-5) Do you realize that your life is ruled by the Sovereign Ruler and Omniscient God of Daniel? (Daniel 2:20-23, 27-28; 4:34-35) Do you trust in the God of the Psalms, who does as He pleases? (Psalms 115:3; 135:6) Do you pray to the God of Abraham, who calls those things that are not as though they were? (Romans 4:17) Have you met the God of Paul, who is King of Kings and Lord of Lords? (1 Timothy 6:14-16).

You will serve the God you see.

- God is sovereign. God’s rulership is universal. It is not confined by time or place. God sovereignly rules the affairs of nations. He does not bow to man’s

laws.

- God is Holy. Holy is a Bible term that means “set apart.” God is separate from all other things, and is 100% pure in everything. He is set apart because of who He is. He is above all.
- God is omnipotent. He is all powerful. There is no limit to His might. You can’t make him illegal.
- God is omniscient. We can’t even conceive the vast capabilities of “his mind”. He knows, and sees, everything. (Get your brain around that one.)
- God is immutable. He never changes. He is eternally the same. He is not subject to your opinions of Him.
- God is wrathful. Most folks don’t want to hear that, but it is His Wrath that made Jesus’ incarnation necessary. If we deny His wrath, we deny our need for the Gospel.
- God is just. We often mistake fairness for justice. His justice demands judgment and punishment.
- God is love. The love of God is not some sickly sentimental thing that is like the cotton-candy love humans express to one another. It is the underpinning of His nature. His mercy triumphs over judgment.

So let me ask you again. What do you see in your mind’s eye when you picture God?

Let me put it to you another way. When you think of Jesus do you think of Mr. Rogers or Braveheart? Does He remind you of your mother or your father? Of a cheerleader or a linebacker? As a lion or a lamb?

He is referred to as both; The Lion of the Tribe of Judah, as well as the Lamb of God. Most Christians view Him as the Lamb. Very few see Him as the Lion.

Lambs bleat. Lions roar. How do you see Him?

You will serve the God you see.

“Where are you heading, Coach,” you are probably asking yourself.

We think God is like us: soft, tolerant, flexible because we have created Him in our own image and given Him attributes that we are comfortable with. A God who loves us is much more palatable than a God who is angry with us.

“God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day”

Psalms 7:11. When is the last time your pastor preached that sermon?

I believe that Jehovah is very angry today. He is angry over the sinful condition of His children. He is angry over the cavalier attitude that His ministers take towards sin. He is angry with the “hands off” attitude the “men of the cloth” have taken towards the decadence of the culture. He is angry with our lack of appreciation for the sacrifice of His only begotten son. His is angry with our willingness to “tolerate” sin. He is angry with what Christians are allowing their children to be taught in government schools. He is angry that we have once again turned His temple into a den of thieves.
